Thrive/ P.S.H.E

For PSHE our topic is Being Healthy. Throughout this topic, we learn ways to keep our bodies and minds healthy, including how to have a balanced lifestyle and have good mental health. We also learn how to make informed choices and set our own goals. Our Thrive learning will be learning to identify, acknowledge and celebrate ways in which we are different to each other. We also develop our confidence and listening skills by having opportunities to participate in discussions.

British Values

We will learn about the right of individual liberty this term.

This will involve learning how nobody should try and harm our good name and that nobody has the right to come into our home, open our letters, or bother us or our family without a good reason.

Key Texts / Literacy

We will further develop our understanding of the features, purpose, audience and language of newspaper report before plan, writing, editing and finalising our own.

Then we will research the life of a refugee before writing a text from their perspective. We will explore the features of this text type to ensure it is realistic representation.

We will write our own poetry based on War of the Worlds.

Art / Music / DT

In art this term we will use sketching to draw the surface of the moon and planets. We will use shading and tone to create mood and feeling and organise line, tone, shape and colour to represent forms of movement. We will practice explaining why specific materials have been chosen.

Maths

This half term, we will be developing our understanding of and skills with fractions and mixed numbers. We will then focus on decimals where we will learn to, read, write, order and compare decimals, round decimals numbers to the nearest whole number or to 1 decimal place and solve number problems involving decimals.

Safeguarding

Class assemblies will focus on first aid including bleeding and how to emergency call for help. We will learn about the work and role of foodbanks and develop our understanding of safeguarding using our child-friendly policy, NSPCC—Stay Safe and Speak Out.
