



### Maths

Our topics this term include fractions, decimals and percentages; area and perimeter and statistics.

### Safeguarding

Throughout our Safeguarding assemblies, we will recap aspects of online safety such as creating secure passwords. We will look at equality for all and learn what to do if someone is choking or has a burn. We will also learn about 'Expect Respect' and our child-friendly complaints policy.

### Audience / Community

As part of World Book Day, we will be sharing our love for books around the community by completing a 'book drop' for others to find. We are also hoping to have another author visit.

### Key Skills

As part of our PSHE Money Matters module, we will be developing our knowledge of how to manage money. We will develop our sewing skills in our DT unit.

### ECO

We will focus on water this term and learn about the billions of people living without access to safe water through World Water Day and explore how to conserve water in Forest School sessions.

### Computing

This half term, our topic is data and information. Throughout this unit, we will, be learning how to create spreadsheets.

### Science

Our Science topic this term is Light. We will explore how light behaves, how our eyes see and what causes shadows and reflections. We will also learn about the sun as a light source and white light.

### P.E.

This half term, our indoor unit is basketball and our outdoor unit is outdoor adventure.

### Humanities

This half term, our humanities focus is Geography. We will be learning about different environments. We will be focussing on both the physical and human geographical features of China and The Caribbean. We will also be looking at the world's largest desert and are not always hot.

### Thrive/ P.S.H.E

Our Thrive learning this term will follow our action plan which has been created with the next steps for our right-time learning in mind.

Our PSHE module is Money Matters and throughout this we will be learning how money can impact a person's wellbeing and the risks associated with money, including gambling. We will also consider the jobs we might want to do in the future and the skills we will require for these.

### British Values

We will explore what it means to be 'a part of Britain', including exploring the following Human Right: we all have the right to believe in what we like, to have a religion, or to change it if we wish.

### Key Texts / Literacy

We have two text focuses this term which compliment our over-arching topic nicely. Our first piece of writing will be a story based around the book 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman. Our second piece will be a text called 'The Assassin'. We will continue to develop our Active Reading skills.

### Art / Music / DT
