

<u>Welcome</u>

Welcome to our first newsletter of the year. We wanted to outline some of the important things you will need to know for the coming year including dates for some of the events we already have planned.

PE and Forest School Days

Forest Schools will start from Thursday 8th September. All children will require a change of clothes including long sleeves and long trousers, a waterproof and wellies or shoes which they can get dirty. We have spare wellies in school so please let your child's teacher know if you need to borrow some. Forest Schools will continue whatever the weather usually, with activities adapted to suit the conditions. The days for Forest School are; Year 3 - Tuesday, Year 4 - Monday, Year 5 - Thursday and Year 6 – Friday.

For PE days children should come to school in their PE Kit with their school jumper on. Year 5 will be commencing their PE sessions on Tuesday 6th September, Year 6 and Year 3 on Thursday 8th September and Year 4 on Friday 9th September. Children will have 2 PE sessions per week, 1 indoors and 1 outdoors (weather dependant). Year 6 will be swimming during the Autumn Term and Year 5 during Spring and Summer Terms.

PE Days are; Year 3 – Wednesday and Thursday, Year 4 - Wednesday and Friday, Year 5 – Tuesday and Friday, Year 6 - Monday and Thursday.

Seesaw - Including new Family Messaging

All children in school have access to an account on Seesaw. You should be able to find their login details in the back of their Home School Diary. This is where children can upload photos of work they do, record videos of activities they complete or even when reading at home so a teacher or teaching assistant can see them and reward them for extra that they do at home. In the event of a school closure, we would set work on here for children to complete. Seesaw is also used by classroom staff to send messages to tell you about things that children will be doing in school, especially if they need to bring something with them or if there are changes to the day they usually have PE or Forest Schools. This year we are also introducing Family Seesaw which will be a way for you to communicate with your child's teacher or receive announcements and messages directly, please see the separate detailed sheet which has been sent home with this newsletter which





includes how to set up the app. We encourage you to please load this as we will be looking to save money in school and be phasing out our texting system. You will be able to set up on any phone the app to message your child's class teacher / teaching assistant as well as Mr Brown. We will aim to move all messages from school throughout the year to this instead of our texting service to save school money. Please be advised we still ask that you speak to staff face to face at the end of the day when they bring the class out, or speak to a member of staff in the morning on the gate where you can. Where this is not possible we hope that messaging staff will be easier through Seesaw. Staff will check their messages each day, however please be aware as they are teaching they will not be able to get back to you immediately and so for anything urgent please continue to contact the school office. Staff have also been advised that there is no expectation for them to answer messages outside of their working hours, however we understand this may be the most convenient time for you to send any messages.

Your child should still continue to login as they have been with their own account details. Parents will need to scan their individual code which is on the letter sent home to be able to access announcements and messages. Any announcements which are sent you will not be able to respond to, instead you should send an individual message to the member of staff.

What we are learning

Over recent years we have been developing our curriculum. For each term you can find an overview of what we will be doing, which we review the term before and adapt to the needs of the children in our current classes. Reading

We spend a lot of time in school reading in a variety of ways with all classes each week. Children will be tested using Accelerated Reader to determine which books they should be reading and we carefully monitor this in school. We encourage all children to read at home as well as in school, and children are rewarded for all they read with tokens in school. Please sign in their home school diaries each time they read. There is also a section for you to initial as we offer an extra reward to all children who read 30 times per half term which you can find on page 18-23.





Times Tables

All children will have login details to TTRS (Times Table Rock Stars) in their home school diary. Children can access this at any time and we encourage this as part of their homework. Throughout the year classes and year groups will run different competitions. Times tables is so important to all maths and we want all children to be able to recall their times tables quickly and confidently. Children in year 4 will be tested on all of the times tables towards the end of the year as part of the government tests we carry out annually.

Rewards

In school we have a range of different rewards which your children may come home telling you they have achieved. Children can collect merits which go towards Bronze (50), Silver (100), Gold (150) and Super Gold (200) Certificates each year. Children can also collect tokens which are given to them to reward them for work at home amongst other things. These are then used to buy items from our token shop. As a school we also give out lots of certificates to celebrate children's achievements and effort. These include Headteacher Awards, Mathematician of the Week and Star of the Week.

Thrive

As a school we are proud to have been a Thrive school for a number of years and for our work to have been recognised with an award as a Thrive Ambassador School with Excellence in Relationship. In school we use the Thrive Approach each day in school, through the way we support children who are struggling at any point, in class with Thrive Time lessons as well as 1:1 sessions for some children with a Thrive Practitioner. In addition to this we also run a Family Thrive course for parents to learn about Thrive and be able to use it to support them at home. If you would like to discuss this further or sign up for the next course please speak to Mrs Carr.

Early Help

Sometimes children and families need support and as a school we are here to help. We appreciate how hard it can be to ask for help sometimes, and we will always work with you without judgement to try and help where we can. This can be through work we can do in school with your child, however more often this is through referrals to specialist support which we can access. Over recent





years we have supported for bereavement, children exposed to domestic violence or alcohol or drug addiction with a member of their family. Children's anxiety and mental health has also been an increased concern for many families and one where we have referred to a local organisation called Changing Lives. They are able to work with families and support parents at home to make changes. As a school we are required to send this information but do not receive any of the fines. Please provide as much information with your application and send as soon as you possibly can.
